1) Turn ignition switch off.

2) Disconnect ground cable from battery and wait for at least 20 seconds before starting work.

3) Remove lower cover. < Ref. to 5-4 [W1A0]. \Rightarrow 1 > Disconnect airbag connector (AB3) and (AB8) below steering column.

4) Remove console box. <Ref. to 5-4 [W1A0].☆1>

5) Disconnect 12-pin yellow connector from airbag control module. < Ref. to 5-5 [M2-6]. \Rightarrow 1 >

6) Using TORX® BIT T40 (Tamper resistant type), remove two TORX® bolts. Discard the old TORX® bolts.
